◆ **GROUP DISCUSSION**

Rules & Regulations

1. Each team would be of 10 members selected randomly.
2. Topics would be from science & technology
3. 1 minutes for thinking and 5 minutes for discussion.
4. Students will be selected for the final round and list will be displayed immediately after preliminary rounds, you are responsible for the presence in the final round in time. Thinking and idea generation: 2 minutes
Group discussion : 7 minutes
Conclusion : 1 minutes

Rules & Regulations

1. One candidate at a time
2. One minute for thinking
3. Speak between 1 to 1.30 minutes

◆ **SUDOKU**

Rules & Regulations

1. Time Limit (30 Minutes)
2. Only one puzzle will be given
3. Use of Pencil, Eraser is Allowed

Rules & Regulations

1. The student should carry colors and required decorative materials

1. One team per school
2. Each team should have 8 to 10 members
3. Maximum time allowed is 8 minutes
4. Team needs to arrange their requirements at their own

◆ **GIDHA**

Rules & Regulations

1. One team per school
2. Each team should have 8-10 members
3. Maximum time allowed is 8 minutes
4. Team needs to arrange their requirements at their own

◆ **LAUGHTER CHALLENGE**

Rules & Regulations

1. One team per school
2. Team should not consist of more than 2 members
3. Maximum time allowed is 5 minutes
4. Vulgarity of content and matter is strictly prohibited
